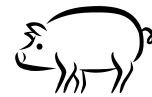

Walnut Grove Learning Center

Thursday, May 28 marked the end to our first official year of preschool. Upon receiving our license in October, we opened our doors with four preschool students. By years end, we had grown to nine. A wonderful sense of community developed among these children as they worked together in the classroom. We were delighted to support them on their first major project: designing and building a bird feeder for our school. This project came about as the children wondered: "Why are the birds not coming?" After sharing many theories and hypotheses, as well as integrating state standards for preschool (measuring, shape recognition, letter formation) the children worked together to offer the birds a new feeder that was placed right outside our classroom window! Imagine the thrill when, eventually, the birds did come! Binoculars, bird identification books, and Elizabeth Township resident and expert, Marian Moeckel, supported the children as they yearned to learn more about these new visitors. They have become an abundant source of knowledge.

An additional 15 children utilize our center for child care. We invite all interested families to call us for a tour of our facility. K We are currently enrolling for the fall (preschool, child care, and before and after care for elementary students.) Let your friends and family know about this hidden gem in rural Elizabeth Township. We are happy to be here.

Elizabeth Township Farmland Preservation News

We are in the final stages of completing the Federal Farm & Ranchland Preservation Program that began back in 2007. The Township was awarded \$600,000 for the purpose of preserving agricultural lands and the funds have to be dispersed by the end of June, 2009.

We have six land owners and seven farms that applied for the program. USDA-NRCS provided \$600,000, the Elizabeth Township Trustees provided another \$672,000, and the land owners donated the final portion of the value of the preservation easement that will preserve approximately 893 more acres in the Township for agricultural use. The Township cost to acquire the easements is approximately \$752 per acre.

The Township Trustees have committed \$1,000,000 annually toward the preservation program and we would encourage any interested township land owners to contact any of the Trustees, the Township office 335-1920, or Randy Mott, Farmland Preservation Chairman 545-8772 for more information.
