ITEM # 1 There was no representative present from the Miami County Sheriff's Department.

ITEM # 2 EMS-Mr. Trusty-Absent

Mr. Dilts reported there was a house fire in Shaggy Bark and the Ring Door Bell captured the fire. The boxes in the bay are still there, Mr. Dilts will work on it.

ITEM # 3 ETCC-Mr. Rice:

\$412.00 was receipted in since the last meeting. There are currently 366 members including spouses and dependents.

What's the plan for the weights? The board voted at the last meeting to donate them to the Miami East High School Athletic Department.

New freezer and tables from WebstaurantStore.com total \$3,319.57. Mr. Rice said the Miami County Health Department told him the township does not need a commercial grade freezer, but the Walnut Grove Learning Center does. A Motion by Randy Mott, Seconded by John R. Ryman to purchase 18 white 30x60 tables at \$54.00 each from WebstaurantStore.com in the amount of \$972.00, plus shipping. VOTE: Mr. Mott-yes, Mr. Dilts-yes, Mr. Ryman-yes. John R. Ryman, President, declared the Motion carried. The board tabled the purchase of a new freezer.

The Shark sweeper purchased in May has a broken handle and is not repairable. A Craftsman V20 Cordless Stick Vacuum at Lowe's is \$199.99 on sale. Mr. Rice said he would like to get a Kobalt tool set for the ETCC from Lowes in the amount of \$99.00 and purchase some garden tools

VOTE: Mr. Mott-yes, Mr. Dilts-yes, Mr. Ryman-yes. John R. Ryman, President, declared the Motion carried.

Mr. Rice proposed ETCC Christmas Eve hours to be 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and New Year's Eve hours to be 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. A Motion by John R. Ryman, Seconded by Randy Mott to approve the ETCC Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve hours as proposed. VOTE: Mr. Mott-yes, Mr. Dilts-yes, Mr. Ryman-yes. John R. Ryman, President, declared the Motion carried.

Mr. Rice shared that Montgomery County Environmental Services will be closing their environmental laboratory to the public as of December 31, 2021. Kevin Krjeny is looking for another lab for ETCC water tests. Mr. Krjeny has not had a pay increase. A Motion by John R. Ryman, Seconded by Randy Mott to raise Mr. Krjeny from \$27.00 per hour to \$30.00 per hour beginning November 13, 2021 for water testing at the ETCC. VOTE: Mr. Mott-yes, Mr. Dilts-yes, Mr. Ryman-yes. John R. Ryman, President, declared the Motion carried.

Mr. Rice said the Breakfast with Santa will take place on Saturday, December 4th. Mary Ann said that Mr. Rice will be contacting her on days when money reaches \$1,000.00 or more, so she can take the deposit to Minster Bank.

- **ITEM # 4** Fiscal Officer presented bills for payment for \$22,533.00. A Motion by Greg D. Dilts, Seconded by Randy Mott to approve the bills for \$22,533.00 as presented. VOTE: Mr. Mott-yes, Mr. Dilts-yes, Mr. Ryman-yes. John R. Ryman, President, declared the Motion carried.
- **ITEM # 5** Mr. O'Neal left a draft of the letter to be sent to Mrs. Taylor on Dayton Brandt Road for board review. Mr. O'Neal to set the date for cleanup with MacX. It was noted that Mr. O'Neal has issued a few permits and he will be looking into the corner lot at the corner of Alcony Conover and State Route 41

Mr. Mott requested a letter from the individual who is interested in purchasing the alley East of Alcony Conover Road, stating what their intention is for the purchase. Once received, we can move forward with the guidance from the Prosecutor. The board discussed a raise for Mr. O'Neal. Mr. Mott said the generator has been installed at the township building and the gas line should be completed by Friday. Earhart to be contacted to have the two propane tanks removed after the craft bazaar.

Mr. Dilts said the cones and an air compressor are at Shaggy Bark, so work may be starting soon.

Mr. Dilts said the mileage certification will be in February.

Mr. Mott said he assumes the flagged and marked markings on the roads is for fiber optic broad band. Mr. Paulus said that Dave Wagner told him Imagine Networks pulled the permit.

ITEM # 9 Mr. Dilts asked if anyone had comments from the Meet the Candidates Night.

Discussion as Follows:

The salt bin curtain is currently not needed but will keep an eye on it.

Tanker truck for the township is not feasible, due to the number of runs the engine makes and shortage of man power.

Having the Sheriff's Department out for extra patrol at \$150,000.00 per year, is unnecessary, due to the number of incidents in the township. Crime rate is low and the biggest concern in the township is speeding.

Lighting updates at the ETCC and parking lots have already been completed.

Question regarding the Historical Society was unclear as to what the question pertained to.

Mr. Mott said he would like to see an accumulative total of runs on the monthly EMS report from Mr. Trusty.
